ABSTRACT

Withdrawal of cyclic load shedding w.e.f 23-05-2012 - Sanctioned- orders issued.

Board vide order cited above has introduced ½ hour cyclic load shedding on all 11kV feeders during evening peak from 6:30pm to 10:30pm w.e.f 02-04-2012 to tide over the critical power situation in the State.

The power position of the State has been reviewed. The total hydel storage as on 23-05-2012 is equivalent to 811 MU. After reserving a water storage equivalent to 550MU as on 01-06-2012, the balance storage is sufficient to generate 24 to 25 MU per day till 31-05-2012. KSEB has been getting about 28.00 MU per day from CGS. Further, KSEB has been importing about 4.00 to 5.00 MU per day as UI at a rate of about Rs 5.00 per unit. Further, about 1.50 MU is being scheduled through traders and energy exchange. In addition to the above, Hon'ble KSERC has approved to procure about 1 to 1.50 MU per day from BDPP, KDPP, wind farms and other small IPPs in the state. Once the load shedding is withdrawn, the energy demand of the State which is now at an average of 57.50 MU/day is likely to increase upto 59.00 MU per day. It is found that KSEB can meet the demand from various sources as detailed above.

Further, KSEB has already made arrangements to procure 210 MW during the month of June-2012, 500 MW from July-2012 to September-2012 and 650MW from the months of October-2012 to May-012 through traders at an average rate of about Rs 4.47 per unit. In view of the above power position, Government vide the letter cited reference has directed to withdraw the load shedding with effect from 23-05-2012. The Full Time Members meeting held on 23-05-2012 has discussed and decided to withdraw the load shedding w.e.f 23-05-2012.

Having considered the power position and direction of the Government, Board hereby orders to withdraw the load shedding w.e.f 23-05-2012.
