Delay in deliveries due to epidemic - Request by M/s.Mehru Electrical and Mechanical Engineers Pvt. Limited, Rajasthan – Granting Delivery Period Extension - Sanctioned - Orders issued.

ORDER

Purchase order was placed with M/s.Mehru Electrical and Mechanical Engineers Pvt. Limited, Rajasthan (MSME) for the supply 245 Nos. of 110kV Current Transformers (Live Tank Type) of various ratings and 119 Nos. of Supporting Structures as per paper read as 1st above with a total contract value of Rs.4,36,95,046/- .

As per the terms and conditions of the Purchase Order, Supply shall be completed within 6 months from the date of Purchase Order as detailed below:

Hence the firm has to complete the supply of the first lot by 24.05.2020. The drawings were approved vide letter dated 05.05.2020. But they have offered the first lot for

inspection on 14.08.2020 due to the current pandemic situation due to Covid-19. Inspection was conducted through video conference on 25.08.2020 and MDCC was issued on 04.09.2020.

The firm, as per letter read as 5th above requested to extend the delivery period for three months since their production facilities are severely affected due to lock down and non availability of imported raw materials especially nano crystalline core from China, insulating paper from Sweden, Germany etc.

The Ministry of Finance, Government of India as per order read as 2nd above has clarified that COVID -19 situation should be considered as a case of natural calamity and FMC may be invoked, wherever considered appropriate. As per memorandum read as 4th above, it is clarified that it may not be possible for the parties to the contract to fulfill contractual obligations due to the restrictions placed on the movement of goods, services and manpower on account of the overseas, countrywide lockdown in terms of guidelines issued under DM Act 2005. The date for completion of contractual obligations which had to be completed on or after 20th February 2020 shall stand extended for a period not less than three months and not more than six months without imposition of any cost or penalty on the contract.

As the occurrence of the pandemic and the subsequent country wide lock down was unexpected, it is recommended to grant extension of delivery period up to 24.10.2020 without imposing penalty, to M/s.Mehru Electrical and Mechanical Engineers Pvt. Limited. The matter was placed before the Full Time Directors as per note read as 6th above.

Having considered the matter in detail, the Full Time Directors in the meeting held on 09.10.2020 resolved to accord sanction to consider the request of the firm for Delivery Period extension up to 24.10.2020 without imposing penalty as the request of the firm is under Force Majeure Conditions of Covid -19.


